



NMITE Switcher Bursary

About

NMITE's Switcher Bursary supports students who want to switch to NMITE from their current place of study. Recognising the financial implications of changing institutions part-way through a course, the bursary makes a significant contribution towards accommodation costs for the first year of study at NMITE.

Bursary Level per individual:

£7,500 for first year of study

The Bursary will be applied as credit towards NMITE accommodation costs.

Bursary Criteria:

To be considered for the Switcher Bursary, applicants must:

- i. Hold a formal offer to study at NMITE; AND
- ii. Be currently studying for a Level 4 qualification or above at a different provider; AND
- iii. Be in a full-year tenancy agreement, i.e. committed to pay accommodation costs for a whole year

Application and Selection Process:

Application Process:

1. Make an application to study at NMITE through UCAS (or directly through our website)
2. You will be notified if your application to study at NMITE is successful. At this stage, you will be notified about any financial awards that are available for you to apply for. Please note that while you may apply for more than one financial award, you can only be in receipt of one.



3. To apply for the Switcher Bursary, you must write a personal statement of up to 500 words outlining your current financial circumstances and the difference this bursary will make to you.
4. You must also submit the additional evidence detailed below.
- 5. Please email your application to bursaries@nmite.ac.uk by 17 February 2023.**
6. Your application will be submitted to the Financial Awards Committee who will make a decision based on the information supplied.
7. You must have formally enrolled on to your course at NMITE to be awarded the bursary.
8. You will be notified of the decision within one week of the closing date.
9. If you choose to accept the bursary, you will be asked to sign a Financial Award Agreement and agree to the Terms and Conditions of the bursary.

Evidence

Sufficient evidence to demonstrate that applicants meet criteria will be required. This will be in the form of the following:

Currently studying for a Level 4 qualification or above at a different provider, and in a full-year tenancy agreement	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Evidence of your tenancy agreement which demonstrates that you are liable to pay the whole costs for the year even if you vacate• A letter from your current place of study confirming your enrolment on the course
