### Quorum



The quorum for the Assessment Board shall be 50% of the committee membership and a simple majority of appointed External Examiners.

#### Terms of Reference:

Drawing on authority delegated by Academic Council and working within the bounds of the General Regulations, Assessment Policy and Programme Regulations, the Assessment Board is responsible for:

- a) Overseeing arrangements and processes for module assessment;
- b) Receiving the results of all assessments undertaken which contribute towards the award of credit;
- c) Arrangements for retrieval of failure;
- d) Applying General Regulations and Programme Regulations relating to progression and eligibility for reassessment, including where special circumstances are involved;
- e) Reviewing, checking and approving assessment profiles leading to named awards;
- f) Determining awards and degree classification for confirmation by Academic Council;
- g) Ensuring compliance with Professional, Statutory and Regulatory Body (PSRB) requirements as appropriate;
- h) Determining exit awards for students who do not qualify for their intended award, or are unable to continue with their programme of study;
- Making decisions regarding the suspension or ending of registration of students who do not meet progression or award requirements;
- j) To consider feedback from external examiners regarding assessment, including areas for development, any cause for concern, and areas of good practice.
