### Scope

The Quality Assurance Committee's remit is to ensure that NMITE's academic standards reflect the expectations of regulators, industry and professional bodies, and to provide an auditable system for demonstrating this is achieved both internally and externally to NMITE. It has the status of a standing committee of Academic Council, and as such any changes to its Terms of reference of membership are subject to approval by Academic Council. (The academic staff representation on the committee will reflect the breadth of the NMITE academic portfolio.)

## Quorum

The quorum for the Quality Assurance Committee (QuAC) shall be 50% of the committee membership.

### Terms of Reference:

Drawing on authority delegated by Academic Council the Quality Assurance Committee is responsible for:

- a) gathering data relevant to QA process from sources such as module and award results, student surveys, and External Examiners reports.
- b) analysing this data and identifying areas of interest/concern and making recommendations to the Academic Affairs Committee.
- c) producing timely reports on the data received and the consequent recommendations made for external audit, the Office for Students, and Professional Engineering Institutions.
- d) producing an annual Quality Assurance report for consideration by the Academic Council and to inform onward reporting to the Board.
- e) overseeing Quality Assurance procedures and practices, adherence to these and the effectiveness of these, including assessment verification, student engagement and programme monitoring.
