1. Transfer Between Programmes

- 1.1 BEng (Hons) and MEng (on both Integrated Engineering and Mechanical Engineering) students are co-taught within their named degree programme through to the end of FHEQ6. Before the start of the Bachelor's Investigative project, students registered on the BEng(Hons) can apply to transfer to the MEng (Hons) programme if they are on track to achieve a weighted mean grade of 50 or more at FHEQ Level 6.
- 1.2 MEng (Hons) students can elect to transfer to the BEng(Hons) programme at any point until the start of the Bachelor's Investigative project.
- 1.3 Once a student graduates from the BEng they are unable to elect to 'top up' to complete the MEng.
- 1.4 To meet with the requirements of the IET, MEng students must achieve a weighted mean level grade of at least 50 at FHEQ Level 6 to be eligible to progress to Level 7 and continue to complete the MEng. Students who have not achieved a weighted mean grade of at least 50 at Level 6, will not be eligible to continue to Level 7 for the award of MEng(Hons) and will exit with a BEng(Hons) qualification.

- 1.5 Personal tutors will ensure students have clear advice on progression, achievement and eligibility to progress to Level 7 at an early stage during Level 6.
